COURSE DESCRIPTION

Online Course (10 weeks)

Teaches students:

- The anatomy, physiology, disease states and drug therapy for various species including canine, feline, equine and exotics
- Resources frequently used for veterinary drug information
- Comprehensive veterinary pharmacotherapy and applications to compounding for veterinary patients
- Legal and ethical requirements of compounding for animals

Laboratory Component (2 days)

The lab component is hosted at PCCA's training facility in Houston, Texas. Students will compound formulas for a variety of animals, and learn from lectures and hands-on demonstrations with live animals.

Prerequisite: Pharmacy Student Boot Camp
